## Electronic Questionnaire (QR code)

Passengers **FROM ALL THE COUNTRIES** (listed or not listed as affected) travelling on international routes organized and operated by carriers as regular, special and charter services by any mode of transport must complete a QUESTIONNAIRE and present the confirmation of the completed electronic form (QR code) to the carrier before boarding the vehicle.

Those arriving in Lithuania from **ALL COUNTRIES** by their **own transport until the moment** of crossing the border of the Republic of Lithuania must **fill in the QUESTIONNAIRE** and provide confirmation of the completed electronic questionnaire (QR code) to National Public Health Center specialists or other officials at the border checkpoint or passenger checkpoint.

- I certify that the information provided is correct;
- I got acquainted with the decision of the chief epidemiologist;
- I have a certificate / laboratory test result form, confirming the negative test for COVID-19 performed not more that 72 hours ago (**if applicable**).

# INFORMATION LETTER

## Self – Isolation and COVID-19 tests

### From self – isolation exempted are:

- High-performance athletes, high-performance sports specialists, high-performance sports instructors and sports medical personnel participating in international tournaments that are subject to separate international rules for controlling the COVID-19 pandemic, and **negative test for COVID – 19** performed with not more that **72 hours** before expected arrival.

### From self – isolation and COVID – 19 tests exempted are:

- Those holding a medical document confirming that they **recovered from coronavirus** diagnosed on the basis of a positive COVID-19 PCR test or an antigen test and that maximum **180 days** have passed from the positive testing;
- Those holding a medical document, a country-specific **vaccination certificate** or an international vaccination certificate confirming that they have gone through the full program of COVID-19 vaccination with **vaccine registered in the Union Register of Medicinal Products**;

For the self-isolation exemption, it is mandatory to provide documentation with confirmation, that exemption is valid for you. These documents can be provided at the point of entry to the country or by the email: [izoliacija@nvsc.lt](mailto:izoliacija@nvsc.lt)

On request we can provide a certificate, to prove the necessity of your presence in the JEGC.

## Permission to arrive

### No need to request permission to arrive:

- From European Economic Area Countries (all European Union countries including Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway) together with the Switzerland Confederation, The United Kingdom of Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Principality of Andorra, the Principality of Monaco, the Republic of San Marino and Vatican.

### Permission is mandatory:

From other countries that are not listed above. The request for the permission shall be filled in a free form to the Ministry of Education, Science, and Sport of Lithuania, by the associated federation or National aeroclub. There should be mentioned:

- Names of the sportsmen and/or the team members.
- The exact date and the name of the competition.
- Additionally, with the form shall be provided sportsmen and all team members (crew, team captain, etc.) personal information by filling the table below:
